A Lenten Journey of Discovery

We are on a Lenten journey. Our sanctuary cross is draped with a purple stole and our altar features a cross, a crown of thorns and dry branches and stones. The church celebrates Lent for 6 weeks before Easter each year. Lent is a penitential season in the church year, a time for considering the human condition with all its flaws and limitations, as well as a time to consider the new possibilities offered to us through Jesus Christ, and implications for a practical life of discipleship.

This month we are singing "Kyrie Eleison" in response to the peace verse, "It is a sin to despise one's neighbor, but blessed is the one who is kind to the needy." Proverbs 14: 21. It's not easy to do all our Christian faith asks of us. With the Kyrie, meaning "Lord, have mercy," we acknowledge our shortcomings and sins, and ask for Christ's forgiveness and the courage and strength to move in new directions.

The disciplines of Lent, practicing giving something up, or trying a new spiritual habit that might become a permanent habit, are an encouragement to strengthen our sagging spirits. We open ourselves to God's grace and the reinvigoration of faith through an honest and penitent look at our shortcomings, and a disciplined commitment to spiritual practices such as attending worship, devotional acts of prayer and reading, charitable giving and participating in mission. By God's grace, the penitential season of Lent can strengthen our faith and permanently alter our habits and values.

We are one congregation, even though you are not physically here! Everyone viewing online is very important to the life of this church. We can see a significant number of "Streamers" are out there every week!





Sunday Unlock & Lockup Person!


